加贺出生于日本, 求学于爱尔兰, 目前是受Mother's Tankstation "哺育"的艺术 家。虽然久居都柏林,但加贺的创作依然带有日本当代艺术的代表性风格一以可爱 而又诡异的卡通形象为主,甚至还带有明显的"御宅族"的气质。

今年的香港之行, 画廊带来了加贺的个人展览, 其中有一件艺术家因日本地震而创作 的作品: 画面中依然是其标志性的拄着拐杖的卡通熊形象, 在震后茫然地举了一支蜡 烛。这个一直带着伤痛的角色被恰好放置在该主题下, 延续了艺术家在暗色调背景中 长存的隐忧。这种对社会的关注不经意间散落于加贺的作品之中,同时还伴有些机智 的幽默。介于欧亚两种文化之间的艺术家借用这种身份上的优势扩大了作品言说的 语境,将东西两端的创作技巧融汇在自己的作品中。

Born in Japan and trained in Ireland, Atsushi Kaga is emerging under the cultivation of Mother's Tankstation. Although he has lived in Dublin for many years, his creative practice contains representative qualities similar to other contemporary Japanese artists-including the cute, quirky visual language of anime, and a noticeable otaku temperament.

This year in Hong Kong, the gallery is bringing the artist's solo exhibition, including a piece created after the earthquake in Japan: an iconic image of a cartoon bear appears in the frame on crutches, solemnly holding a candle. The experience of suffering comes to the surface in the work's theme, revealing the artist's melancholy side. This deep social concern is dispersed throughout Kaga's body of work, though we also find traces of wit and humor. His bridging of Asian and European sensibilities borrows the strengths from each region, expanding the context of the work to create a productive fusion of East and West.
