

Remaking the world

THE UNTITLED FIRST ALBUM Mother's Tankstation, 41-43 Watling St, Usher's Island, Dublin Thurs-Sat noon-6pm Until Nov 15 01-6717654

Kevin Cosgrove's first solo show follows on from his NCAD graduate exhibition and subsequent work. He makes relatively straightforward representational paintings with a beautifully controlled, offhand technique. See just one and you are not quite sure what it is about; see a number of them and an odd thematic consistency becomes apparent.

They share a preoccupation with certain kinds of skilled manual and technical labour, more usually associated with masculine work and pursuits: small boat building, woodworking, engine repair, surfboard manufacture. There is the idea of working on something with a further end in view, a sense of possibility,

even adventure. But they might also be about picture-making itself. Cosgrove's style is a way of remaking the world so that it is charged with interest and promise.

This show features several of his largest paintings to date.
